



For a full description of these limits, refer to Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004 Schedule 12 (Partially Smooth Waters), Schedule 13 (Smooth Waters), Schedule 15 (Dictionary) and Part 2 (EPIRB).

"Smooth waters" (as described in Schedule 15) means the waters-

- of rivers, creeks, streams and lakes; or
- within breakwaters or revetments; or
- described in Schedule 12 that are within 0.5 nautical mile from land; or
- described in Schedule 13.
